Insight Pre-Intermediate: unità 1-7 (interamente svolte) + unità 8 e 10 (grammatica)

Vocabulary: adjectives+prepositions, feelings, everyday objects, compound nouns, asking for personal information, collocations with *make* and *do*, phrasal verbs with *get*, talking about similarities and differences, routines, free-time activities, describing places, places in town, the senses, descriptive adjectives, giving directions, geographical features, food and nutrition, life cycle of food, drinks, cooking tools, food adjectives, inviting, containers, household chores, compound adjectives, asking permission, houses and homes, parts of a house, adjective suffixes *-ing -ed*, noun suffixes *-ment, -ion*, base and strong adjectives, describing a photo, stages in a journey, experiences, fears and phobias, expressing addition, crime, negative prefixes *un-, im-, ir-, il-*, offers and suggestions, school bad behaviour, parts of school, statistics, nouns with two meanings, business, asking for and giving advice.

Grammar: present simple and continuous, articles, past simple and continuous, linkers and linking phrases (*while, as, when, also, too, as well, however, although, in addition*), determiners (*a lot of, a little, little, a few, few, some, any, much and many*), indefinite pronouns and adverbs (*some-, any-, no-, every-*), relative pronouns and adverbs, adverbs of manner and comment, verbs + *ing* or *to*, adverbs of degree, comparative and superlative adjectives, (*not*) *as ...as, too, enough*, present perfect (*already, just, yet*), *for and since, will, going to*, zero, first and second conditional, *must, have to, mustn't, don't have to, should,*

ought to, expressing probability (*may, might, can, could, certainly, probably, likely, unlikely...*),
used to, passive forms, past perfect.
